ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

This program provides educational scholarships to high school seniors and college students who have a financial need, are interested in pursuing a degree in the arts or business, demonstrated scholastic achievement and dedicated to community service.

REQUIREMENTS for High School Students

- A completed application packet.
- A high school senior student and/ or young adult from Pulaski County Special School District, Little Rock School District, North Little Rock School District or Conway School District.
- Submit completed application between January 1st - March 22, 2019
- Complete a 300 word essay on double spaced, "Explain how today's economy is affecting your pursuit of a college education."
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Minimum 2.5 GPA (high school or college).
- Legal U.S. Resident.
- Sealed official transcripts and letters of recommendation must be postmarked by March 22, 2019.
- Attending or planning to attend an accredited college or university.
- Copies of ACT (20 or higher) Scores (high school students only).
- High School Seniors submit two Letters of Recommendation. One from an academic teacher or employment supervisor and another from a school official (i.e. guidance counselor, a principal or an assistant principal) who can verify scholarship of student.
- Letters must be in an envelope with the proper seals and signature of the guidance counselor. NO PHOTOCOPIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

REQUIREMENTS for College Students

- College students submit one reference letter.
- Minimum 2.5 GPA
- Sealed official transcripts and letter of recommendation must be postmarked by March 22, 2019.

Awarded recipients will be notified by April 13, 2019.

Application Deadline must be postmarked by March 22, 2019

3. **LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION:** on official school letterhead- provide two letters of recommendation, one from an academic teacher and another from a school official (i.e. - a guidance counselor, a principal or an assistant principal) who can verify scholarship of student.
